To provide you the very best care and protection, we monitor closely the information from the UK government, the NHS and the General Osteopathic Council.

- The clinic is currently open offering appointment only consultations with priority being given to emergency and urgent cases. In addition we are offering remote services via phone for new and returning patients giving care in the form of education and advice.
- All patients visiting the clinic are advised hand-washing and/or hand sanitiser gel before and after treatment. We are using single use paper barriers and diligently dis-infect between each patient visit all contact points and areas possibly exposed to aspirants in treatment rooms. We are regularly cleaning our entry, waiting area and lavatory.
- Practitioners may wear PPE consistent with government advice, will regularly wash their hands, apply hand sanitiser and monitor/protect their own health.
- We have reduced and staggered appointments so as to avoid patient interactions. We have removed all reading material from the waiting area.
